West Pine Middle Orchestra Information


Welcome to WPM Orchestra! This year, students will play a varied repertoire of music on stringed instruments alone and in a group setting. They will also explore different styles of music from classical to fiddling to world music. In addition to music theory, history, composition activities and improvisation, they will be learning advanced techniques such as shifting, scale studies, and vibrato.

Instruments

School instruments are available for those students who are unable to rent or purchase an instrument. Please let me know as soon as possible if your child will need to use one. Students will be expected





In my classroom, I have 3 general expectations of all students: respect their right to learn, my right to teach, and each others' instruments and personal belongings. I expect and reward student effort and hard work. Rewards for appropriate behavior include classroom award/free time, contact with parents, grading period award. Consequences for inappropriate behavior include teacher interventions (verbal warning, change seat), written action plan, contact with parents, and referral to administration. Students will be expected to correctly wear a cloth face covering over their nose and mouth at all times in the classroom. Students will NOT share instruments during the 2021-2022 school year. Because orchestra is a team effort and everyone plays an important role in the success of the group, students are expected to abide by the WPM R.O.A.R. motto.

Grading Orchestra grades are based on the following:

★ Participation - 50 points weekly using following rubric:

50	Exhibits exceptional behavior, providing a model for others. Attention does not waver from rehearsal.
48	Listens attentively much of the time. Needs few teacher reminders to refrain from talking/interrupting and consistently follows the rules for appropriate participation.
44	Needs occasional teacher reminders to listen attentively and/or refrain from talking. Leaves seat and/or plays instrument at inappropriate times.
35	Needs frequent teacher reminders for appropriate rehearsal participation. Often talks/plays out of turn, making it difficult for other students to listen attentively.

- ★ Classwork 10 points per classroom activity
- ★ Homework practice 5 points per week
 - Assigned Monday, due the following Monday
